^{*} Fee does **not** include a trail ticket. Discounted tickets are available for athletes and coaches and must be pre-ordered via Zone 4: \$20/adult and \$5/child (plus HST). Discounted rates are not available from the venue on the day of competition.

the surrounding trails.

AWARDS: An awards ceremony will be held on site following the race. Teck provides

awards for the first five in each sub-category based on year of birth from Pee Wee to age 14. There will be participation awards for all Atoms and Pee Wees. There will be medals for the first three in each category from Junior Girls/Boys

upwards.

TEAM AGGREGATE: Club points are accumulated for each skier who successfully completes the race. Cross **AWARDS**Country BC will post the aggregate points earned by participating clubs as they

accumulate throughout the season. The winner of the Club Aggregate Award will be the club with the most points. The Club Aggregate Award will be presented immediately

after the final race of the season has been completed.
