


Winter Wonderland for Teck Coast Cup #4

Sea to Sky Nordics was proud to host Teck Coast Cup #4, an individual Start Classic Technique event at Whistler Olympic Park on January 28, 2018. The weather created a winter wonderland with heavy snow fall before and during the race. Despite challenging conditions there were 191 racers from regional clubs with smiles on their faces: Sea to Sky Nordics (Squamish), Hollyburn (N. Vancouver) CCSC, Whistler Nordics, Spud Valley Nordics (Pemberton), and Nordic Racers (Vancouver). Classic skiing proved to be a good choice for the event.
