The Teck Coast Cups 5 & 6 took place this past weekend at Mount Washington (Nordic Area & Raven Lodge) on Vancouver Island. These events were hosted by the Strathcona Nordic Ski Club and participants attended from Vancouver, Squamish, Whistler and Pemberton as well as a number of communities on Island. The Teck Regional Cup Series is held in regions across the province, is sponsored by Teck Resources Limited, and has a focus on the early stages of athlete development – namely children 14 years and younger.
