The Bulkley Valley Cross Country Ski Club (Smithers, BC) welcomed 88 athletes, age 4 and up, to the Teck Northern Cup #2 Classic race, Sunday, February 11, 2018. With temperatures around - 10 C and 35 cm of fresh snow having fallen in Smithers the week prior to the race, snow groomers had plenty to work with and classic ski conditions were just about perfect. Distances ranged from 0.77 km for the youngest to 7.5 km for the older skiers.
