- Bunnies and Atoms will race 1 heat. Start area is different for this age group.
- All other categories will have 3 heats depending on numbers in category
- Heats will have 6 racers per heat (max)
- Top two finishers will move up, bottom two will move down and middle two will remain level
- Genders will be combined for all age categories, but separated for awards
- Depending upon the level of participation, categories may be combined.

Race Location:

Nelson Nordic Ski Club, Hwy 6, 10 km south of Nelson, BC Parking is limited at the trails, so please restrict the number of vehicles your team brings to the main parking lot, and park any extra vehicles in Busk parking lot 700m south of main parking lot on Hwy 6.

Registration Deadline:	10:00 p.m. (PST) on Thursday, February 21st th Please note, there will be <u>no registrations on race day</u> .
How to Enter:	Click on https://zone4.ca/reg.asp?id=20324 to register. Fees are payable by credit card only, and terestrictional.com processing fee.
	Racers and coaches must check the confirmation list on Zone4 (<u>www.zone4.ca/</u>) as soon as possible after they complete their registration to ensure that they are registered in the correct categories. Please contact the Race Secretary (<u>klpoole@shaw.ca</u>) before 10 a.m. on Friday Feb 22nd if there are any corrections required.
Event Waiver:	The Event Participation Waiver is completed as part of the online registration.
Dinner Tickets:	Burger and Beverage event at Finley's from 6-8pm. \$15 Tickets available through Zone4.ca when you register. 50/50 draw too!!!
Race Fees:	 \$5.00 (plus GST and Zone4 fees) per race for Bunnies. \$10.00 (plus GST and Zone4 fees) per race for Atoms, Peewees, and Bantams. \$20.00 (plus GST and Zone4 fees) per race for all other age categories. Payment must be made online. Credit cards only. Race fees will include a meal ticket for soup and a bun on each day. **Free for NNSC Bunnies and Jackrabbits with password (ask your coach)
Licenses:	No race license is required.
Start Lists/Maps:	Start lists and maps will be posted race day at 9 a.m. on the board outside the Nelson Nordic warming hut and kiosk. Maps will also be posted on www.nelsonnordicski.ca by Feb. 15th.
	On race days, skiing on the race course is allowed up to 15 minutes prior to the start of the races, but there will be no skiing backwards on any of the race courses at any time.
	Skiers are responsible for knowing their course prior to the race.
Bib Pickup:	Bib pickup at the Nelson Nordic warming hut at Apex 8:30-9:30am each day.
Facilities:	There is a warming hut and first aid kit near the course start on Saturday. No warming hut at Sunday's start. Outhouses are located at both race locations. No indoor waxing facilities are available at the race site. No power for waxing on Busk side on Sunday.
Trail Passes:	Race entry fees include full use of trails for the race days only. Trail passes must be purchased at the trailhead kiosk for skiing on non-race days. Group discounts are available at the kiosk for non-race days. Up to 2 coaches/team will be given complimentary trail passes for race days, but ONLY if they have pre-registered on Zone4 as a "coach". All extra coaches and parents will need to purchase day passes. Day passes may be purchased at the Nelson Nordic trailhead kiosk.

Warm-up/Wax Testing:	The race courses will be clearly marked and marshalled. The race course will be open for inspection 8:30 – 9:45 a.m. Feb 23 rd and 24th. No wax testing allowed on the course during the various races.
Waxing:	Uncovered, outdoor waxing is available, with several plug-ins available on the Apex side. There is no power on the Busk side for Sunday's race. You may want to bring a generator or wax on Apex side. Teams are welcome to set up their own tents for waxing.
	 The Nelson Nordic Ski Club requests that all coaches, wax technicians, and parents abide by the below self-governed protocol while waxing skis for all athletes (this includes all age groups and recreational skiers). The recommended glide waxing protocol is as follows: Structure tools ARE permitted Non Elyese (NE) or Low Elyese (LE) glide wayes ARE permitted
	 Non-Fluoro (NF) or Low Fluoro (LF) glide waxes ARE permitted Medium Fluoro (MF) or High Fluoro (HF) glide waxes are NOT permitted Pure Fluoro glide waxes (powders, pucks, blocks and liquid) are NOT permitted Cold weather powder additives and hardeners are NOT permitted
	The adherence to this protocol is self-governed and is the responsibility of the athlete, coaches, parents and wax technicians
Water:	There is no running water and no other food to purchase except the soup and bun, so bring enough food and water for the day. We will have water on site while quantities last.
Food and Drinks:	Post-race drinks and light snacks will be offered to racers in the finishing chute. Warm lunch will be provided to all racers and volunteers both Saturday and Sunday in our Apex hut. Please be green and bring your own bowl and spoon for both days. Meal tickets will be distributed with the bibs in the morning. Each registered athlete will receive one complimentary meal ticket/day. Additional meal tickets will be available for purchase on Zone4 for \$5 each, or on site while quantities last.
Awards:	Awards will be presented outside the Nelson Nordic warming hut following the races. Ages 7 and under receive Teck participant ribbons as they cross the finish Age 8-15: Teck medals for top 3 finishers; Teck ribbons for 4th and 5th finishers Age 16 and up: Edible medals for top three men and women finishers in each category

this event. Under circumstances of event cancellation, the Host club will refund 50% of race fees. Zone4 online booking fees are non-refundable.
