A warm-up area will be available in the vicinity of the race start.

Low-fluoro glide waxing protocol applies for all ages:

Structure tools ARE permitted.

Non-Fluoro (NF) or Low Fluoro (LF) glide waxes ARE permitted. Medium Fluoro (MF) or High Fluoro (HF) glide waxes are NOT

permitted.

Pure Fluoro glide waxes (powders, pucks, blocks and liquids) are NOT

permitted.
