BC Winter Games: All competitors aged 13 or 14 are eligible to compete to attend the BC Winter

Games. In order to be eligible, you must race in your Zone trial race, in your age category for the specified maximum distance of 3.5 km for YOB 2006 and 5.0 km for YOB 2005. Each zone is eligible to send 4 female and 4 male competitors. The first two finishers in each of the 4 categories (2006 Boys, 2006 Girls, 2005 Boys, 2005 Girls) automatically qualify. New this year, there are 8 additional positions provincially for competitors who self identify as having indigenous ancestry. If athletes decline their position it will be offered to the next athlete in

the same category.

the Friday prior to the race and posted at the lodge on race morning.

Bib Pick-Up: Race day, 9:45 a.m. to 10:30 a.m., at the ski lodge.

Awards: Award presentations will take place immediately following the race. Awards for

athletes 15 years and younger will be provided by Teck Resources Ltd. Ribbons and medals will be given to participants aged 15 and younger, as follows: 1st, 2nd, 3rd place medals for age categories 8,9,10,11,12,13,14,15 - both male and female will be awarded. Ribbons for 4th and 5th place skiers will be provided for

the above age categories, as will participant ribbons for all children 7 years of age and younger. Awards for older athletes will be provided by BV Nordic.

Concession:

Soup, bun and a drink will be provided to all racers and volunteers. Spectators may purchase food.

Waxing:

The Gary Murdoch Memorial Waxing Hut will be available for waxing. The CCBC Glide Waxing Protocol will apply to all categories: Cross Country BC respectfully requests all coaches, wax technicians, and parents abide by a self-governed protocol while waxing skis for athletes racing in the Midget age categories and younger. This request applies to all local, regional and provincial events taking place in British Columbia (e.g. Championships and the BC Winter Games). This request also applies to athletes traveling to BC from out-of-province or out-of-country.

The recommended glide waxing protocol is as follows:

- Non-Fluoro (NF) or Low Fluoro (LF) glide waxes ARE permitted
 Medium Fluoro (MF) or High Fluoro (HF) glide waxes are NOT permitted
- Pure Fluoro glide waxes (powders, pucks, blocks and liquid) are NOT permitted
- Cold weather powder additives and hardeners are NOT permitted The adherence to this protocol is self-governed and is the responsibility of the coaches, parents and wax technicians.

Trail pass:

Registered racers can use trails for the day of the race. Spectators do not require a trail pass to watch the race. Family and coaches of racers from out of the Smithers-Telkwa area can request complimentary trail passes for the day of the race.

Cancellation:

There will be no refund for participants who choose to not start their race. If race organizers cancel the race(s) due to unsafe weather conditions. A full refund will be made to participants except for any online processing fees. Races will be cancelled or postponed if temperature or weather conditions are unsuitable at start time.

With air temperatures below -20°C (temperature measured at the coldest point of the course and without wind factor) and competition distances less than or equal to 15 km, the Jury must postpone or cancel the competition. For U10 and younger, with air temperatures below -15C (temperature measured at the coldest part of the course and without a wind factor), the Jury must postpone or cancel the competition.

Route maps will be posted at the lodge prior to the race and on the BV Nordic website.
