Awards:

Award presentations will take place immediately following the race. Awards for athletes 15 years and younger will be provided by Teck Resources Ltd. Awards for older athletes will be provided by BV Nordic.

Concession:

Soup, bun and a drink will be provided to all racers. Spectators may purchase food. *NEW – Extra lunches can be pre purchased on Zone 4 at the time of registration.

Waxing:

The Gary Murdoch Memorial Waxing Hut will be available for waxing. The CCBC Glide Waxing Protocol will apply to all categories: Cross Country BC respectfully requests all coaches, wax technicians, and parents abide by a self-governed protocol while waxing skis for athletes racing in the Midget age categories and younger. This request applies to all local, regional and provincial events taking place in British Columbia (e.g. Championships and the BC Winter Games). This request also applies to athletes traveling to BC from out-of-province or out-of-country.

The recommended glide waxing protocol is as follows:

- Non-Fluoro (NF) or Low Fluoro (LF) glide waxes ARE permitted
- Medium Fluoro (MF) or High Fluoro (HF) glide waxes are NOT permitted
- Pure Fluoro glide waxes (powders, pucks, blocks and liquid) are NOT permitted
- Cold weather powder additives and hardeners are NOT permitted The adherence to this protocol is self-governed and is the responsibility of the coaches, parents and wax technicians.

Trail pass:

Registered racers can use trails for the day of the race. Spectators do not require a trail pass to watch the race. Family and coaches of racers from out of the Smithers-Telkwa area can request complimentary trail passes for the day of the race.

Cancellation:

There will be no refund for participants who choose to not start their race. If race organizers cancel the race(s) due to unsafe weather conditions. A full refund will be made to participants with the exception of any online processing fees. Races will be cancelled or postponed if temperature conditions are unsuitable at start time.

With air temperatures below -20°C (temperature measured at the coldest point of the course and without wind factor) and competition distances less than or equal to 15 km, the Jury must postpone or cancel the competition. For skiers born 2005 and later, with air temperatures below -15C (temperature measured at the coldest part of the course and without a wind factor), the Jury must postpone or cancel the competition.
