CANCELLATION: There are no refunds of any kind once a racer registers and then subsequently withdraws

from the race or does not show up for the race.

No refunds will be issued if the organizers are required to cancel the race due to weather or

other unforeseen circumstances.

DRAW: Start position for both free technique individual start and classic mass start will be

determined by random draw. There will no seeding.

START LISTS: Start lists will be posted on http://zone4.ca after the Team Captains' Meeting the night

before the race and printed copies will be available Saturday morning & Sunday morning

after 8:30 a.m. at the Nickel Plate Nordic chalet.

BIB PICKUP: Bibs will be available for pick-up at Nickel Plate during the following times:

Saturday: 9 a.m. -10 a.m. (race start 11 a.m.) **Sunday:** 8 a.m. -9 a.m. (race start 10 a.m.) **All bibs not picked up will be marked DNS.**

AWARDS: An awards ceremony will be held on site each day following the races.

CLUB AGGREGATE AWARDS:

The winner of the Club Aggregate Award will be the club with the most points. The Club Aggregate Award will be presented immediately after the final race of the season.

Top 5 placing in each category	7 (for first place), 6, 5, 4, 3 points				
If there are less than five competitors in a category, the points will still begin at 7					
points for 1 st place, 6 points for 2 nd place, etc.

WAXING: A waxing trailer is available for use at Nickel Plate Nordic (limited space). Space will be

available for setting up 10x10 tents, BYOEC (bring your own extension cord).

WARM UP/ WAX TESTING:

A warm-up area will be available in the vicinity of the race start.

Low-fluoro glide waxing protocol for Okanagan Cup applies to all ages:

• Structure tools ARE permitted.

• Non-Fluoro (NF) or Low Fluoro (LF) glide waxes ARE permitted.

• Medium Fluoro (MF) or High Fluoro (HF) glide waxes are NOT permitted.

• Pure Fluoro glide waxes (powders, pucks, blocks, and liquids) are NOT permitted.

• Cold weather powder additives and hardeners are NOT permitted.
