ELIGIBILITY: Skiers must have a signed waiver in order to participate in this race (signed by their parent or guardian if under 19).

Credit card payment is required. One entry per team (team captain to register all 3 teammates). E-mail confirmation after registration will be sent if you have registered correctly. Entry fee is \$30/team.

BIB PICKUP: Bib pickup for the race will be at Beaton Provincial Park between 1-2pm on Saturday March 9th, 2019. Bibs must be picked up by 2pm. All those left will be marked DNS.

AWARDS: There will be an awards ceremony following the race.

FACILITIES: Outdoor pit toilets are available as well as a shop and small warming hut.

PARKING: Please park in the designated lot or along the road in the event that the parking lot is full.

WAXING: A limited number of electrical outlets are available in the shop for waxing irons.

WARM UP/ WAX TESTING:

A warm up area will be available in the vicinity of the race start.

COURSES: A course map will be posted online under “Tag the Jay Relay” at <https://whiskeyjacknordic.ca/tag-the-jay-relay-race-march-9/> as soon as the course has been finalized.

CONCESSION: Light refreshments (fruit and Gatorade) will be served during and after the race.
