- Distance:** 10km or 5km - **CLASSIC TECHNIQUE ONLY**

### RACE COURSE (may be subject to change due to snow conditions):

This is a snowmobile groomed track through private properties in the Pemberton Valley. Please be respectful of the private landowners who have graciously permitted us to use their land for this long-running Pemberton event. You will ski through fields, along the Lillooet River, through forests. Start/Finish is the same location. There will be a sweep of the course at the end of the race.

## REGISTRATION & FEES (Fee schedule below is same for both distances):

Pre-registration is strongly recommended at [www.zone4.ca](http://www.zone4.ca) (search for “29th Annual Spud Valley Loppet”). **Pre-registration closes on Friday, Jan. 31 st at midnight.** Race day registration available from 9:00-9:45am, **fees will increase by \$5.00** on the race day.

A potluck–style lunch will be served at Fougberg House, Coast Mountain Outdoor School. There will be awards for all age categories for the 10km race. ***Awards for 5km race will be up to 8 years old only.***

### MISCELLANEOUS INFO:

1/ **NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED ON THE COURSE OR ON FARM PROPERTY, THANK-YOU.**

2/ All parents/guardians who wish to ski along their child(ren) must register & pick up bib, too.

3/ Sorry but **no chariots on the race course** as many parts of the track are very narrow.

4/ There will be a portable toilet at the START/FINISH area.

## 5. TRAVEL TO THE START OF THE RACE:

**From Downtown Pemberton** (Scotia Bank/Pemberton Valley Supermarket)

15-20min drive.

- Turn right at the Scotia Bank stop sign in downtown Pemberton
- Turn left at the T-intersection and stop sign at Spierings Automotive
- Travel approx. 20 km along the Pemberton Meadows Road
- Turn right onto the Lillooet Forest Service Road
- Look for signs and a tent at the start area on the Van Loon Farm
