



### Team Sprints for Coast Cup #3

On Saturday, February 8th, the Spud Valley Nordics (Pemberton, BC) hosted the 3rd Coast Cup of the 2019-20 Teck Coast Cup Regional Series. The event was held at Whistler Olympic Park in the Callaghan Valley. There were 124 athletes racing, ranging in age from 5 to 50+. The athletes were from five clubs - Hollyburn Cross Country Ski Club, Sea To Sky Nordics, Spud Valley Nordics, Whistler Nordics and Nordic Racers – plus a team from UBC.

The racers took part in team sprints, where each team of two did three legs alternately; sprint distances ranged from 100 metres for the Under 10's, to 1000 metres for Open Men & Open Women. They raced in warm and sunny weather which was a nice change from the freezing cold temperatures of the days previous.
