Waxing Protocol Teck Regional Cup races, please see CCBC Low- fluoro Glide.

### Low-fluoro glide waxing protocol applies to all ages for Coast Cup:

- Structure tools ARE permitted.
- Non-Fluoro (NF) or Low Fluoro (LF) glide waxes ARE permitted.
- Medium Fluoro (MF) or High Fluoro (HF) glide waxes are NOT permitted.
- Pure Fluoro glide waxes (powders, pucks, blocks and liquids) are NOT permitted.
- Cold weather powder additives and hardeners are NOT permitted.

**Concession:** A light lunch will be served to athletes in the technical building after the races (usually bagels, apples and oranges). A food concession is available on site at the Day Lodge.
