Teck Kootenay Cup #3 & #4, held in Invermere, BC, saw record breaking numbers.

The weekend kicked off on Saturday, January 24<sup>th</sup> with the mass start, classic technique races. Organizers and racers were met with extremely difficult conditions following a full day of rain on Friday and freezing temperatures overnight. As a result he course was HARD and the klister was flying Saturday morning! Fortunately the sun came out during the day and cheered spirits up. 297 skiers aged three to 70 competed. Racers were welcomed back to the finish area with a nice juicy burger and an awards ceremony.

Sunday was the mass start, free technique (skate) races. The course conditions had improved immensely due to the hard work of the grooming crew and the sun was shining again as the racers headed out on the course. We had another record breaking day, this time with 195 participants.

The weekend's races, which were held in conjunction with the Nipika Toby Creek Loppet, drew participants from all over the East Kootenays - Kimberley, Fernie and Golden - as well Revelstoke, Vernon, Kitimat, the US, Saskatchewan and Alberta.
