START LISTS: Start times will be posted online by the evening prior to both events.

There will be no qualification rounds. Genders will be mixed for all categories.

U10 and U12 may be combined depending on numbers.

Predicted order of events and timing for the Saturday King's Court Sprints:

9:30 – Mass start for Bunnies (Ribbons provided after the race)

9:45 – Kings Court for U8 categories

10:15 – Kings Court for U10 categories (depends on numbers)

10:45 – Kings Court for U12 categories (depends on numbers)

11:45 – Awards for U8, U10, U12 (by gender and age category)

12:15 - Kings Court for U14 categories (depends on numbers)

12:45 – Kings Court for U16 and Older

2:00 – Awards for U14 and Older (by gender and age category)

- Bunnies will race 1 heat. Start area is different for this age group.
- Atoms will race King's Court format (2-3 heats depending on numbers start area different for this age group.
- All other categories will have 3 heats depending on numbers in category
- Heats will have 6 racers per heat (max)
- Top two finishers will move up, bottom two will move down and middle two will remain level
- Genders will be combined for all age categories, but separated for awards
- Depending upon the level of participation, categories may be combined.

a generator if you want power.

Registration 11:00 p.m. (PST) on Wednesday February 12th

Deadline: Please note, there will be <u>no registration on race day</u>.

How to Enter: Registration and fee payment are online at www.zone4.ca/

Click on Teck Kootenay Cup #7 and #8 to register.

Fees are payable by credit card only, and there is an additional Zone4 processing fee.

Racers and coaches must check the confirmation list on Zone4 (www.zone4.ca/) as soon as

Bib Pickup: Team Bib pickup at the Nelson Nordic warming hut by 8:45 a.m. Feb 15th.

Water: There is no running water so bring enough water for the day. We will

have water on site while quantities last.

Food: Post race drinks and a light snack will be offered to racers in the finishing

> chute. Meal tickets for the Saturday and Sunday meals will be available for purchase on Zone4 for \$6 or on site for \$7 each while quantities last. Saturday menu is Coconut Curry Butternut Squash Soup with a bun or bread.

Sunday menu is Vegetarian Chili with a bun or bread.

Race volunteers will receive a ticket for a free lunch – available in hut.

There are no other options to buy food or beverages at the warming hut, so bring enough

food and water for the day.

Facilities: There is a warming hut and first aid kit near the course start at Apex. No

warming hut at Busk. Outhouses are located nearby. No indoor waxing

facilities are available at the race site.

Trail Passes: Race entry fees include use of trails for the day of the race. Trail passes

> must be purchased at the kiosk for skiing on non-race days. Up to two coaches per team will be given free day passes. All extra coaches and

parents will need to purchase day passes if they ski.

Warm-up/Wax

The race courses will be clearly marked and marshalled. The race course will be open for inspection 8:30 – 9:30 a.m. Feb 15th. Testing:

No wax testing allowed on the course during the various races.

Waxing:

Uncovered, outdoor waxing is available, with several plug-ins available at Apex. Teams are welcome to set up their own tents for waxing.

The Nelson Nordic Ski Club requests that all coaches, wax technicians, and parents abide by the below self-governed protocol while waxing skis for all athletes (this

includes all age groups and recreational skiers).

CCBC Low Fluoro Glide Waxing Protocol:

· Structure tools ARE permitted.

- · Non-Fluoro (NF) or Low Fluoro (LF) glide waxes ARE permitted.
- · Medium Fluoro (MF) or High Fluoro (HF) glide waxes are NOT permitted.
- · Pure Fluoro glide waxes (powders, pucks, blocks and liquids) are NOT permitted.
- · Cold weather powder additives and hardeners are NOT permitted

Awards: Awards will be presented outside the Nelson Nordic warming hut

following the races according to the timing schedule above. Bunny

awards will be given directly after their races.

Cancellation Policy:

50% refunds will be provided to participants who wish to withdraw provided notice of withdrawal is emailed to info@nelsonnordicski.ca no later than Feb. 1st. The Host Club may choose to cancel an event if travel or course conditions are deemed unsafe (road conditions, road closures, weather, lack of snow, health advisory). The Host Club is not liable for any costs incurred as a result of cancellation of this event. Under

circumstances of event cancellation, the Host club will refund 50% of race
