## 2013-14 COLLEGE/UNIVERSITY AGGREGATE AWARDS PROGRAM (BC Cup Series)

The objective of this program is to establish college/university cross-country racing "teams" at post secondary educational facilities in British Columbia, and to support the preparation of student/athletes who wish to compete for Canada in the sport of cross-country skiing at the World University Games (Winter Universide).

## **Eligibility:**

- (1) Athletes must be full time students according to the policies of the post secondary educational institution they are attending, and
- (2) Notify the CCBC Office of their student status and their interest in participating in this series (i.e. register).

## **Aggregate Awards Guidelines:**

The six "individual" races in the BC Cup Series will be used to compile points for the Aggregate Awards.

- A competitor must be registered in the BC College/University Aggregate Awards Program (see above).
- A competitor must compete in at least four of the six races.
- •. The winner will be determined by points from the competitor's four best (of a possible six) races. A minimum of two classic and two free technique events must be included among the four events selected to determine the points.
- In the case of a tie, where the total points are the same, the winner will be decided by the number of first place finishes. If there is still a tie, a tie will be declared.
- It is not necessary to compete in the BC Championships to win an aggregate award.
- A competitor must have a valid CCC Racing Licence.

The Aggregate Awards will be presented at the banquet & awards ceremony at the BC Championships.
