It has a full service lodge, rental shop and biathlon range with over 60 km of Nordic trails and over 50 km of single track trails for snowshoeing and summer use. It regular hosts events such as the Canada Winter Games, Local, Provincial, National and North American Championships for cross country and Biathlon. It has two PB100 groomers (2007, 2015) as well as numerous modern Skandic snowmobiles and Yellowstone and Ginzo mechanical groomers. Summer equipment includes various tractors, mowers and hand equipment. The club strives to only have the best of equipment available for use. Fully equipped maintenance and storage buildings are provided.

This position works collaboratively with the director of trails and reports to the CNSC General Manager.

Accountabilities

The Grooming Supervisor / Trails Manager is responsible for the grooming and maintenance of ski trails to the grooming standards of the club. They are responsible for supervising and training groomers, and planning and coordinating the grooming schedules. They are responsible to ensure that all grooming and trail maintenance equipment are in good working condition.

Responsibilities

- Plans and coordinates all grooming work schedules. Provided weekly work schedules to the General Manager.
- Oversees the training of all grooming and maintenance staff.
- Ensures all grooming staff are fully capable of carrying out necessary maintenance checks on equipment.
- Ensures all groomers understand the functions of all machines controls.
- Responsible for ensuring that the groomers are operating in a safe manner.
- Works with groomers, to ensure that all ski trails are groomed and maintained (weather permitting), according to club policy.
- Ensure minor repairs and preventative maintenance on all machines and equipment are carried out in accordance with club policy.

- Ensures that all work areas are maintained in a safe and efficient manner.
- Ensure sufficient stock of spare part or consumable parts for grooming equipment is maintained.
- Reports equipment malfunctions, damage and required repairs, to the general Manager and Director of Trails, in a timely manner.
- Is point of contact and coordinates with heavy duty mechanic for major repairs and maintenance required on equipment.
- Schedules and organizes repairs to minimize equipment downtime.
- Ensures that equipment hours, incidents, damage, equipment malfunctions are recorded in log books in an accurate and timely manner.
- Collaborates and works with trails committee to establish grooming standards.
- Ensure summer trail maintenance such as mowing and brushing is carried out as per club policy
- Work with the director of trails to develop the yearly budget plan.

Demonstrated Abilities

- Experience grooming in all conditions with various types of grooming equipment.
- Knowledge of grooming equipment maintenance requirements.
- Familiar with planning and scheduling summer maintenance activities including, mowing and brushing.
- Proven mechanical experience in the ski, or heavy equipment industry or strong mechanical aptitude.
- Good communication skills and the ability to work in a dynamic team environment.
- Good organizational and interpersonal skills.
- Motivated to work independently, take a leadership role, and able to work with minimal supervision.
