The Haywood NorAm Western Canadian Championships and Teck Coast Cups #2 & #3 concluded yesterday. The event was a tremendous success and it was one of the biggest races held at Whistler Olympic Park since the 2013 Haywood Ski Nationals.

Over 600 athletes aged 5 and up competed over the weekend. Participants travelled from across Canada, and included an Australian development team. The event drew aspiring Olympians and some very big names in Canadian cross country skiing, including Olympians Emily Nishikawa and Dahria Beatty.

The racers participated in sprints, distance races, and Sunday's closing event was a team relay, a new format for the race series. The relays were well attended and a hit with all the athletes.
