- **BIB PICK UP SAT** Bibs can be picked up on February 28th, 8:00 9:30 am in the Race Office in the Technical Building, next to the Stadium area.
- KIDS CHECK IN SUN 0930: 5-9 yrs @ X-Country stadium. 10-14 yrs @ Biathlon stadium.
- **START LISTS**: We recommend that you <u>check</u> the Zone4 confirmation list for this event to be sure you have <u>registered correctly</u>. Start lists will be available from the Race Office on the day of the event and posted online on Zone4 on Friday, February 26th.
- **FOOD / WATER**: For races of 15 km or more, there will be feed stations. Please see course maps. There will be a feed station in the stadium area, as well as on course.
- **CUT-OFF TIME**: All skiers not reaching the 25 kilometre point in the 50 kilometre event after 2.5 hours will not be allowed to continue.
- **RESULTS**: Unofficial results will be posted outside the Race Office after the race. After the event, results will be available to review on Zone4.
- **AWARDS**: Awards will be presented on venue at the conclusion of the races.

DRIVING TIMES: Whistler to WOP 30 minutes Squamish to WOP 60 minutes Vancouver to WOP 120 minutes
