Saturday saw the sprints in the skate/free technique, and racers were challenged by sharp, climbing turns on the ascents and hairpin turns on the descents. Andrews and Latta made it through their qualifiers to reach the quarterfinals. Mehain and Oliphant both attained their second golds.

In the skate/free technique distance races Sunday, Mehain ranked sixth after completing three grueling laps of a 3.3km course, while Embleton finished in the top half of his division.

Andrews, Smedley, Latta and Loewen battled through two laps of the same course. The mass start made for some exciting scrambles with 40-50 racers in each category. All four had respectable midpack finishes.

Oliphant made it a golden hat trick by topping the Midget boys, who raced a two-lap 2.5km circuit.


