A seeding order will be created based on the results of the Teck OK Cup #6 race held on Saturday, January 31st.

START LISTS

Start lists will be available on Saturday, January 31st on www.nickelplatenordic.org, and also posted in the Nickel Plate Lodge on the morning of the race. Bibs will be distributed on Sunday morning from 8:00am-9:30am.

CLUB AGGREGATE AWARD

Club points are accumulated for each race in the Teck Okanagan Cup series and an award is given to the club with the most points at the end of the final race. Points are earned for top 5 finishers and for participation, so encourage your club to attend all Teck Okanagan Cup races. Club aggregate awards will be presented at the end of the race.

Club Points

1st place = 7 points

2nd place = 6 points

3rd place = 5 points

4th place = 4 points

5th place = 3 points

Participation (completing your course) = 2 points

INDIVIDUAL AWARDS

- -TECK participation ribbons will be awarded to all Atoms.
- -Ribbons will be awarded to all participants under 14.
- -For ages 9-14, medals will be awarded for all 1st, 2nd and 3rd place finishes and Teck ribbons awarded to 4th & 5th finishers in each age category.

Awards will be presented immediately after the race.

CONCESSION

WAXING

There is a waxing area inside the Lodge. However, it will get crowded easily and teams will need to share outlets.

COURSE INSPECTION/WAX TESTING

The race course will be marked and open for inspection by noon on Saturday February 1st. The courses will close 30 minutes before the start. Wax testing lanes will be clearly marked.

TRAIL PASSES

Trail passes are included in the fees for all competitors. Anyone wanting to ski during the event must have a valid trail pass. Skiing alongside the racers on the course during the competition is specifically NOT PERMITTED.

In the VERY unlikely event the event is cancelled there are no refunds. The decision regarding cancelling or postponing will be made on race day.


PARKING
