### RACE REGISTRATION

Registration and fee payment is ON-LINE ONLY at <u>zone4.ca</u>. Coaches should register on Zone4 (no fee). **Confirmation Lists will be sent in advance via email to coaches who are registered.** 

If you experience any difficulties registering on-line please contact the Competition Secretary.

Racers and coaches **must** check the confirmation list on Zone4 (<u>zone4.ca</u>) as soon as possible after completing registration to ensure skiers are registered in the correct categories.

Please contact the competition secretary (<u>race@sovereignlake.com</u>) before 12 noon on Thursday, January 6<sup>th</sup> if corrections are required.

Late entries will only be accepted at the discretion of the jury and will incur an additional \$25 late fee per race. Late entrants will not be seeded.

#### **LICENSES**

Competitors in Midget, Juvenile, Junior and Open categories must have one of the following valid licenses to be eligible to race in the BC Cup.

- FIS Race License
- CCC Race License or
- CCC Supporting Member Day License (purchased with online registration for each competition day)
- Other National Ski License

CCC Race Licenses must be ordered in advance from CCC at: <a href="https://store.cccski.com/apps.asp">https://store.cccski.com/apps.asp</a> and cannot be issued by the race organizers. The CCC Race Licenses will be verified prior to race to ensure that they are current.

Competitors in the **Bantam and younger or Masters categories do not need a license** to compete, but must be members in good standing of a CCC/CCBC club for the 2015-2016 ski season. Those who are not CCC/CCBC members must purchase membership in the host Sovereign Lake Nordic Ski Club in order to enter in this competition. Names of new club members will be registered with CCBC to meet insurance requirements.

#### **WAIVER FORMS**

Waivers must be accepted on line.

### **SEEDING**

Competitors in the Open Men and Junior Men categories and those in the Open Women and Junior Women will be combined for seeding purposes and will compete as a single Open competition. The categories will be separated into Open and Junior for results and awards/prizes. The current Canada Points List (CPL) for both distance and sprint competitions will be used.

There will be no seeding for categories that do not require a race license.





Order of start will be by random draw.

**DRAW** Order of start will be determined on Thursday, January 7<sup>th</sup>, 2016.

START LISTS Start lists for the Saturday race will be available by noon, Friday, January 8<sup>th</sup>

on **Zone4.ca** and at the Sovereign Lake Nordic Centre. Start lists for Sunday's

race will be available after the awards presentations on Saturday.

**BIB PICKUP** Saturday between 7:30 and 9:30 AM in the Race Office

Sunday between 7:30 and 9:30 AM in the Race Office

The Race Office is the brown log cabin located behind the green Technical

Building.

**AWARDS** Participation ribbons will be awarded to all Atom and Peewee1 skiers at the

finish line. There will be two awards presentations (in the stadium) on each

race day. The top five finishers in the Peewee, Bantam, Midget and

Juvenile1 age categories, and the top three finishers in the older categories

will be recognized.

**FACILITIES** SLNC offers a heated day lodge with indoor washrooms. In addition,

outhouses will be located close to the parking and stadium areas. First aid

attendants will be available on site.

**FOOD & DRINKS** Drinks and snacks will be available to racers at the finish line. Members of

the SLNC Junior Development team will be selling chili as a fundraiser to support travel to the 2016 Nationals. A limited selection of other food and drinks is available for purchase at the Sovereign Lake day lodge. Full service restaurants, cafes, pubs and a small grocery store are available at

Silver Star Mountain Resort (3km away).

**WAXING** Teams are welcome to set up tents for waxing in the parking area between

the lower parking lot and the day lodge. There is an adequate supply of power available to connect extension cords. There is no waxing on the decks of the main day lodge. The wax cabin is for the use of recreational day

skiers only.

CCBC WAXING PROTOCOL

Cross Country BC respectfully requests all coaches, wax technicians, and parents abide by a self-governed protocol while waxing skis for athletes racing in the Midget age category and younger. This request applies to all local, regional and provincial events taking place in British Columbia (e.g. Championships and the BC Winter Games). This requesst also applies to athletes traveling to BC from out-of-province or out-of-country. The

recommended glide waxing protocol is as follows:

• Non-Fluoro (NF) or Low Fluoro (LF) glide waxes ARE permitted

- Medium Fluoro (MF) or High Fluoro (HF) glide waxes are NOT permitted
- Pure Fluoro glide waxes (powders, pucks, blocks and liquid) are NOT permitted
- Cold weather powder additives and hardeners are NOT permitted

The adherence to this protocol is self-governed and is the responsibility of the coaches, parents and wax technicians.

TRAIL PASSES

Trail passes for Friday (training day) and for Saturday and Sunday race days

are included with race fees.

Dual Area Trail passes (covering both Sovereign Lake and Silver Star trails) for the preceding Monday to Thursday will be available for racers and

coaches at 50% off the regular day pass cost.

**CANCELLATION** 

Any change in the event location or timing will be posted as early as it is known on the Sovereign Lake web site <a href="www.sovereignlake.com">www.sovereignlake.com</a>. Where possible a decision on event cancellation or change of site will be made by the organizing committee one week prior to the event in consultation with the Technical Delegate. Where possible a suitable alternative site within driving

distance will be identified at the time of cancellation.

COLD WEATHER PROVISIONS:

Races will be cancelled or postponed if temperature conditions are unsuitable at start time. Notice will be posted on the event webpage.

With air temperatures below -20°C (temperature measured at the coldest point of the course and without wind factor) and competition distances less than or equal to 15 km, the Jury must postpone or cancel the competition.

For Atom and Pee Wee age groups, with air temperatures below -15C (temperature measured at the coldest part of the course and without a wind factor), the Jury must postpone or cancel the competition.

**REFUNDS** 

In the event of cancellation, a refund of registration fees less administration and event expenses already incurred will be provided.

A refund of individual registration fees will only be provided for medical reasons and if the competition secretary receives notification WITH medical

documentation prior to the registration deadline on January 6<sup>th</sup>.
