REFUND POLICY: 75% refunds will be provided to participants who wish to withdraw provided

notice of withdrawal is emailed to the Race Secretary no later than Jan 18th at

10pm. Zone 4 online booking fees are non refundable.

Please Note! This event **WILL NOT** be cancelled regardless of road closures, which are a possibility this time of year. We recommend staying in Revelstoke the night before the race and consulting **Drive BC** for current road conditions.

START LISTS: Start lists for the Saturday race will be available by noon on Zone4.ca Friday

January 23, 2014 and at the Revelstoke Nordic Lodge.

DRAW: A random draw will be held on Thursday January 22nd, 2014 and start lists

for both Saturday and Sunday events posted on Zone4 by noon Friday.

CCC RACE LICENSE: Competitors in Juvenile, Junior and Open categories must have a valid license at

the time of registration closing to be eligible to race.

CCC Racing Licenses must be ordered in advance from CCC and cannot be issued by the race organizers. The CCC Racing licenses will be verified prior to

race to ensure that they are current. Apply for a Race License here.

SEEDING: Competitors in the Senior Men and Junior Men categories and those in the

Senior Women and Junior Women will be combined for seeding purposes and will compete as a single Open competition. The categories will be separated into Open and Junior for results and awards/prizes. The current Canada Points List (CPL) for both distance and sprint competitions will be used. There will be no seeding for categories that do not require a racing license (i.e., midgets and

under, or masters). Order of start will be by random draw.

BIB PICKUP: Bib pick-up for Saturday's race will be at the Revelstoke Nordic Lodge –

Ticket Office 8:30am to 9:30am on Saturday January 24th, 2015. Bib pick-up for Sunday's race will be at the Revelstoke Nordic Lodge –

Ticket Office 8:00am to 9:00am on Sunday January 25th, 2015.

WARM UP/ WAX TESTING: The race courses will be marked and open for inspection by 1pm Friday.

The lodge and courses are open until 9:30pm on lit trails. On race days, course

closure 30 minutes prior to the race start.

No wax testing allowed on the course during the competition.

WAXING: There is limited power supply and teams may have to share a connection.

Power bars are strictly prohibited. There are six exterior plug-ins available.

Tent coverage for group waxing may be required.

IMPORTANT The Revelstoke Nordic Ski Club is hosting a No High Fluoro wax event. We ask that all skiers in all categories refrain from using high fluoro wax (and powders) at our event because of health, cost and environmental concerns. We thank you in advance.

CCBC GLIDE WAXING PROTOCOL FOR MIDGET AGE CATEGORIES AND YOUNGER:

Cross Country BC respectfully requests all coaches, wax technicians, and parents abide by a self-governed protocol while waxing skis for athletes racing in the Midget age categories and younger. This request applies to all local, regional and provincial events taking place in British Columbia (e.g. club races, loppets, regional cup races, BC Cup races, BC Championships, BC Midget Championships and the BC Winter Games). This request also applies to athletes traveling to BC from out-of-province or out-of country.

The recommended glide waxing protocol is as follows:

- Non-Fluoro (NF) or Low Fluoro (LF) glide waxes ARE permitted
- Medium Fluoro (MF) or High Fluoro (HF) glide waxes are NOT permitted
- Pure Fluoro glide waxes (powders, pucks, blocks & liquid) are NOT permitted
- Cold weather powder additives and hardeners are NOT permitted

The adherence to this protocol is self-governed and is the responsibility of the coaches, parents and wax technicians.

AWARDS: Individual awards will be presented following completion of the events:

Ages 7 and under receive Teck participant ribbons as they cross the finish
 8 year olds – Teck Ribbon for top 5 finishers; Teck participant for all others
 Ages 9-14: Teck medals for top 3 finishers, Teck ribbons for 4th and 5th finishers

Age 15: Club medals for top 3 finishers

Medals for top three finishers in all junior, open and master categories

Revelstoke Nordic Lodge Friday Jan 23rd at 1pm.

TRAIL PASSES: There is no charge for trail use fees to athletes, coaches or persons assisting

coaches on official training days or race days. Those wanting to recreational ski during the event must have a valid trail pass. Skiing alongside the race courses

during competition WILL NOT be permitted.

PARKING: PLEASE NOTE THAT PARKING WILL BE LIMITED ON RACE DAYS. Each team

will be able to park two vehicles at the day lodge parking lot, larger teams will receive an additional 1-2 parking passes. Drop offs of equipment and passengers permitted. **Do not** park on HWY 23S. On race days a 25 passenger shuttle bus (two at peak times) will run continuously from designated parking 7km away from

7 am until 4pm on Saturday and 2pm on Sunday.

SHUTTLE SERVICE IS MANDATORY for any vehicle that does not display a parking permit. Parking permits for teams will be available for pickup from the ticket office on Friday afternoon and Saturday morning. Maps of all available

parking areas will be posted to the Revelstoke Nordic Ski Club Website.

FACILITIES: A day lodge with a First Aid facility is at the race site. The day lodge has indoor

washrooms. Additional outhouses are located close to the parking and stadium

area.

CONCESSION: A concession will be available in the Nordic lodge on both Saturday and Sunday.

Healthy snacks, coffee, hot chocolate and a lunch of chili, chicken noodle soup

and a vegetarian soup will be available for purchase.

ACCOMMODATION: Accommodations in Revelstoke book up quickly during the winter months. It is
