^{*} Registration fee includes a light lunch of bagels, cream cheese, fruit, cookies, and hot chocolate post-race for all competitors and will be served in the Flex Space in the Technical Building. Whistler Cooks provide an excellent assortment of food and drinks for purchase at the concession at the Day-lodge. Hot and cold drinks will be available at the finish line.

NOTE: Atom boys & girls will participate in a 200-300m Mad Dash.

TEAMS: Each team will comprise of two skiers who will complete the course 3 times in the

relay.

In category #2 (Pee Wee Boys & Girls) may be same sex or mixed but in all other categories any mixed sex team will be listed as unofficial unless the mixed team competes in a male category in which case it will be an official team.

When a skier initially registers, he/she can move up an age category, but not down.

Depending on the number of entries, there will be a semi final heat (First race starts at 10 am) and a final heat (starting at 12:30) in each category.

^{*}Fee does not include a trail ticket, which will be available for purchase as part of the online registration at a discount rate; not required if you have a Whistler Olympic Park season pass, which must be purchased before registering for the race and the pass number or confirmation number must be entered when registering for the race.

VOLUNTEERS: Volunteers can sign up online through Zone 4 from January 10th.

FACILITIES: A day lodge and washrooms are located at Whistler Olympic Park

DOGS: No dogs on the snow in the stadium please.

CONCESSION: A food concession operated by Whistler Cooks is found in the Day-Lodge.

WAXING: A limited number of electrical outlets are available outside the Technical Building

for waxing irons. Waxing trailers are available for rent at Whistler Olympic Park for \$30 per day. Contact them at 604-964-0060 or 1-877-764-2455 for further

details or to book a trailer.

Please note that the course will not be open for wax testing/training on race day but that wax testing/training is possible off-course closer to the day lodge or on

the surrounding trails.

AWARDS: An awards ceremony will be held on site following the race.

All Atoms will receive participation awards.

Teck medals and/or Teck Ribbons will be awarded to eligible finishers for category

#2 to #6. Host club awards for top 3 finishers for category #7 to #11.
