RACE REGISTRATION:

ELIGIBILTY and LICENSES:

This race is designed to appeal to racers of all levels. Races licenses are not required for this event. Racers must be paid-up members of a Cross Country Canada or US Ski Association registered club.

Please note that late entries will **not** be accepted

RACE FEES:

\$10 per race for Bunnies

\$10 per race for Atoms, Pee Wees, Bantams, Midgets.

\$20 per race for Juvenille, Junior, Open Rec.

\$40 per race for all other categories

Note that GST and Zone4 fee will be added to this amount.

Payment must be made online. Credit cards only.

WAIVER FORMS:

Waivers must be accepted online at the time of registration.

START LISTS:

Start times (by category) for each race will be posted the race office

BIB PICKUP:

Saturday and Sunday: 9:00 AM - 10:00 AM, in the Barn. All bibs must be picked up by 10 AM

AWARDS:

Awards will be presented on site at intervals after a few race categories have been completed.

WARM UP/ WAX TESTING:

The course will be open until 10:15 at which time all skiers need to be off the course.

FACILITIES:

There will be outhouses located close to the parking and stadium areas. First Aid attendants will be present on site.

FOOD & DRINKS:

Post-race complimentary drinks and BBQ burgers & wieners will be offered to racers and volunteers. Family members, spectators and coaches may purchase lunch tickets at the site for \$5

WAXING:

An area is available near the barn for waxing but without any facilities. The area is in the open with no cover. Note that **NO** power outlets will be available at the site. Teams are welcome to set up their own tents for waxing.

The **CCBC Glide Waxing Protocol** will apply to all categories: Cross Country BC respectfully requests all coaches, wax technicians, and parents abide by a self-governed protocol while waxing skis for athletes racing in the Midget age categories and younger. This request applies to all local, regional and provincial events taking place in British Columbia (e.g. Championships and the BC Winter Games). This request also applies to athletes traveling to BC from out-of-province or out-of-country.

The recommended glide waxing protocol is as follows:

- Non-Fluoro (NF) or Low Fluoro (LF) glide waxes ARE permitted
- Medium Fluoro (MF) or High Fluoro (HF) glide waxes are NOT permitted
- Pure Fluoro glide waxes (powders, pucks, blocks and liquid) are NOT permitted
- Cold weather powder additives and hardeners are NOT permitted

The adherence to this protocol is self-governed and is the responsibility of the coaches, parents and wax technicians.
