- RACE ENTRY DEADLINE:** Entry deadline is: **Wednesday, January 27th, 2016 12 NOON**
- LICENCES:** No licences are required, however, all competitors must be a member in good standing of a CCC /CCBC club.
- SEEDING:** Order of start will be by random draw.
- REFUNDS:** Race fees are non-refundable. Refunds will only be issued for those competitors who withdraw from the race prior to the race entry deadline of January 27th, 2016 12 noon.
- START LISTS:** Start lists for each day of racing will be posted at the Telemark Chalet and available on-line at www.zone4.ca.

RACE OFFICE:	The event race office will be in the downstairs of the Telemark Chalet from 8AM – 2PM.
BIB PICK-UP:	Bibs will be distributed from the Race Office.
AWARDS:	Teck, a diversified resource company based in BC, is the title sponsor of the Okanagan Cup series. Teck provides the awards for ages 14 and under. All Atoms will receive a special Teck participant ribbon. Awards for ages 15 and over will be provided by Telemark. Awards ceremony will occur directly after the race is completed.
CLUB AGGREGATE AWARD:	Club points are accumulated from each race in the Teck Okanagan Cup Series. An award is given to the club with the most points at the end of the final race. Points are earned for top 5 finishers and for participation.
CONCESSION:	There will be a concession available.
FACILITIES:	There is a day lodge at the race site. Portable toilets will be located close to the stadium area.
TRAIL FEES:	No pass is required on the competition day for racers and coaches.
WAX FACILITIES:	Outdoor electrical outlets are available on the roadway leading from the parking lot to the stadium. Waxing is not permitted in the day lodge. Additional power will be made available from the 'old' groomer shed, located nearest to the Telemark chalet, however, it is on a first come, first 'plugged-in' basis. Teams are encouraged to bring portable generators and tents.
WAX TESTING:	NO WAX TESTING ALLOWED on the course. No exceptions. A wax testing area will be designated.
GLIDE WAX PROTOCOL:	<p>Cross Country BC respectfully requests all coaches, wax technicians and parents abide by a self-governed protocol while waxing skis for athletes racing in the <i>Midget age and younger categories</i>. This request applies to all local, regional and provincial events taking place in British Columbia (e.g. club races, loppets, regional cup races, BC Cup races, BC Championships, BC Midget Championships and the BC Winter Games). This request also applies to athletes traveling to BC from out-of-province or out-of-country.</p> <p>The recommended glide waxing protocol is as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Non-Fluoro (NF) or Low Fluoro (LF) glide waxes ARE permitted · Medium Fluoro (MF) or High Fluoro (HF) glide waxes are NOT permitted · Pure Fluoro glide waxes (powders, pucks, blocks and liquid) are NOT permitted · Cold weather powder additives and hardeners are NOT permitted <p>The adherence to this protocol is self-governed and is the responsibility of the coaches, parents and wax technicians.</p>
