Series of XC ski races at Whistler Olympic Park a great success this past weekend

Hollyburn Cross Country Ski Club and Whistler Olympic Park hosted a series of races this past weekend. Teck BC Cup #1, Coast Cups #2 & 3, and BC Winter Games Trials (for zones 3, 4 & 5) saw a great turnout as athletes from all over the province competed. There were some challenging snow conditions as the temperature hovered around zero, but rain held off for the most part.

Events were integrated into two main races. On January 6th there was a classic technique course and on January 7th there was a mass start free technique event. Course distances ranged
