The Teck Coast Cup races #3 and #4 took place on Feb 19th and 20th, 2022 at Strathcona Nordic Ski Club at the beautiful Mt. Washington ski resort on Vancouver Island. After a season of cancelled races due to the pandemic, these events were well attended with fresh air, huge smiles and plenty of cheer!

Strathcona Nordics played host, receiving racers from Vancouver Island Biathlon (Mt. Washington), Hollyburn Cross Country Ski Club (West Vancouver), Spud Valley Nordic Ski Club (Pemberton BC) and Nordic Racers (Vancouver). Skiers ranging in age from 3 to 65 years old competed in the two days of racing.

Day one was characterized by weather typical for Vancouver Island ranging from snow showers to sunshine with everything in between. 158 racers paired up to compete in the team sprint free technique event. The sun came out on day two as 154 racers put their fitness, technique and wax wizardry to the test in a mass start classic technique race.
