BC Winter Games: Athletes born in 2007 or 2008 will be notified and given the option of

attending the BC Winter Games if they qualify. Note all athletes, coaches, officials and spectators attending BC Winter Games will be required to be fully vaccinated with a Health Canada approved COVID-

19 vaccine.

Indigenous Participation Program

Cross Country BC in partnership with the Indigenous Sport, Physical Activity & Recreation Council (I-SPARC) and the BC Games Society will be offering an Indigenous participation initiative for the Vernon 2022 BC Winter Games. Up to eight athletes, two coaches and two officials with Indigenous ancestry will be eligible to attend the Games. These spots are in addition to the number of athletes and coaches that are already

permitted to attend the Games.

Current Northern Health Order requires that all spectators 12 and up

must show proof of vaccination to enter the event area.

All racers 22 and older will require proof of vaccination.

Please be aware that Public Health Orders may change and participant

requirements may need to be altered. Please consult the event website regularly

for updated notices and changes.

**Draw:** Start lists will be posted at the Race Office on race morning.

Bib Pick-Up: Race day, 9:45 a.m. to 10:30 a.m., at the Gary Murdoch Wax Hut.

**Awards:** Award presentations will take place immediately following the race. Awards for

athletes 15 years and younger will be provided by Teck Resources Ltd. Ribbons and medals will be given to participants aged 15 and younger, as follows: 1st, 2nd, 3rd place medals for age categories 8,9,10,11,12,13,14,15 - both male and female will be awarded. Ribbons for 4th and 5th place skiers will be provided for the above age categories, as will participant ribbons for all children 7 years of age and younger. Awards for older athletes will be provided by BV Nordic.

**Concession:** Bagged lunch will be provided to all racers and volunteers. There will be no

concession for spectators.

Waxing:

**Due to COVID policy**, the Gary Murdoch Memorial Waxing Hut will **not** be available for waxing on the day of the race.

Outdoor electric plug ins will be available for hot irons.

**CCBC Protocol Regarding the Use of Fluorinated Waxes**

### Non-fluoro waxing protocol applies to all ages:

- Structure tools ARE permitted.
- Only identified non-fluoro (NF) glide waxes are permitted
- Fluorinated grip waxes ARE permitted

Trail pass:

Registered racers and coaches will be provided a trail pass for the day of the race at the race bib handout location. Spectators do not require a trail pass to watch the race. If you are not a racer or a coach you will require a day pass to use the trails on the day of the race.

Cancellation:

There will be no refund for participants who choose to not start their race. If race organizers cancel the race(s) due to unsafe weather conditions, a full refund will be made to participants except for any online processing fees. Races will be cancelled or postponed if temperature or weather conditions are unsuitable at start time.

With air temperatures below -20°C (temperature measured at the coldest point of the course and without wind factor) and competition distances less than or equal to 15 km, the Jury must postpone or cancel the competition. For athletes under 12 years of age, with air temperatures below -15C (temperature measured at the coldest part of the course and without a wind factor), the Jury must postpone or cancel the competition.
