About Us:

The Caledonia Nordic Ski Club (CNSC) is a not-for-profit organization with over 2,800 members, dedicated to providing high-quality recreational and athletic outdoor experiences, including world-class competitions. We are seeking an experienced and dedicated Trails Manager to oversee the maintenance and grooming of our 55 km of ski trails and 50 km of singletrack trails used year-round.

Position Overview:

As the Trails Manager, you will report directly to the General Manager and work collaboratively with the Director of Trails, the Trails Committee, and club staff. You will be responsible for the planning, maintenance, and grooming of CNSC's extensive trail network, ensuring optimal conditions for all users. The Trails Manager will also be responsible for overseeing both competition and recreational grooming operations, ensuring high-quality trail conditions for all users. Strong interpersonal skills will be essential, as the role involves engaging with club members and stakeholders who are passionate about the trails and eager to provide feedback.

Potential Addition:

Additionally, there is potential for this position to evolve into a year-round role in collaboration with the Prince George Cycling Club (PGCC). If an agreement is reached and the successful





applicant is interested, the position could be shared between the two organizations. During the summer months, the role would primarily focus on singletrack maintenance at Pidherny, Otway, and Tabor. In the fall, winter, and spring, the primary focus would be on grooming operations as the Trails Manager at CNSC.

Key Responsibilities:

Collaborative Planning & Leadership

- Work with the General Manager and Director of Trails to develop annual budgets and operational plans.
- Collaborate with the Trails Committee to establish grooming standards, priorities, and trail-related policies.
- Strategize grooming schedules to ensure high-quality trail conditions in alignment with the Grooming Policy.

Trail Maintenance & Grooming

- Plan, coordinate, and oversee grooming operations, including scheduling and execution.
- Ensure effective summer maintenance, including clearing, mowing, re-routing, and repairing trails.
- Manage and operate snowmaking equipment to supplement grooming operations.
- Work early mornings or late nights as required to ensure trails are groomed for public use.

Equipment Operation & Maintenance

- Oversee operation and maintenance of grooming equipment, including snowmobiles, groomers, ATVs, tractors, mowers, ginzus, chainsaws, and power tools.
- Maintain inventory of spare parts and consumables for grooming equipment.
- Coordinate with mechanics for major equipment repairs and preventive maintenance.





• Ensure accurate recording of equipment hours, malfunctions, and repairs in logbooks.

Staff Training & Supervision

- Recruit, train, and oversee grooming and maintenance staff.
- Ensure staff are proficient in equipment operation, safety procedures, and maintenance protocols.
- Monitor team performance and provide guidance to ensure high-quality grooming and maintenance standards.

Safety & Compliance

- Ensure all work areas and activities comply with CNSC safety standards and policies.
- Implement best practices for risk management and emergency procedures related to trail grooming and maintenance.

Qualifications & Skills:

- Proven leadership experience, with the ability to motivate and manage a team.
- Strong organizational and planning skills, with attention to detail.
- Experience operating and maintaining heavy-duty equipment.
- Knowledge of trail grooming requirements for both recreational and competitive use.
- Ability to work collaboratively with management, coworkers, and volunteers.

- Familiarity with software for scheduling and reporting.
