Promoting and ensuring Safety in Sport is a cornerstone to the coaching practice in Canada. As such the National Sport Organization, along with our PTSO divisional partners, are continuously implementing measure that will contribute to cultural shifts that support furthering safe and ethical sport.

You are receiving this message as notification of changes to the 2022-2023 coaching license requirements since you registered for the current sport year.

All active coaches must now complete the Coaches Association of Canada's **Safe Sport** (~ 90 minutes) and **Understanding the Rule of Two** (~ 20 minutes) e-learning modules. These free modules are available in The Locker. We would ask that you check your personal information in the locker and proceed as necessary.

The expectation is all coaching license holders be in compliance by January 1st 2023.

Thank you for your efforts to make cross country skiing a safe sport for all participants.
