REGISTRATION:	Registration and fee payment is <u>through Zone4</u> . Racers and coaches must check the confirmation list on Zone4 to ensure participants are in the correct categories. Email RaceSecretaryBJSC@gmail.com by 9:00 AM on Friday, January 19 if corrections are required.			
DEADLINE:	Registration deadline is Wednesday, January 17, 2024 at 11:59 PM (PST)			
LICENSES:	All participants must purchase a Nordiq Canada Tier 3 Event Day License. The license is only valid for the competition day for which it is issued and will be automatically added to registrations on Zone4.			
START LISTS:	Start times will be posted at the race office and online on Friday Jan 19 for the Classic Technique, Interval Starts and on Saturday Jan 20 for the Free Technique, Mass Starts.			
BIB PICKUP:	Saturday: 9:30 AM -10:30 AM in the Race Office Sunday: 8:00 AM - 9:00 AM, in the Race Office Race Office is in the grooming shed, adjacent to the trailhead cabin. No bib-pick-up within 30 minutes of the start of races.			
AWARDS:	U8 and U6 – Participant ribbons U10 to U16 – Teck Medals for top three finishers, Teck Ribbons for 4 <sup>th</sup> and 5 <sup>th</sup> U18 and up – Local Medals			
	U6 athletes will receive their ribbons directly after their event. U8 and U10 athletes will have awards presented as soon as results are available. All other age groups will have awards presented approximately 30 minutes after the final racer has finished.			

- **FACILITIES:** A heated trailhead cabin is available with outhouses located nearby. First aid attendants will be present on site. There are no dogs allowed on the trails, except for the <u>designated dog trails</u>.
- **FOOD & DRINKS:** Post-race drinks and a cookie will be offered to racers in the finishing chute.
- **WAXING:** An area is available to set up waxing tents to the east of the finish line, near the sea cans. Waxing in the parking lot is allowed for wax trailers. Limited power is available (six duplex outlets).
