1. What age group is the BunnyRabbit Program for?

 The BunnyRabbit Program is geared for children 5 years of age and younger

2. What age group is the JackRabbit Program for?

a. Each club is entitled to ONE free shipment between January 9th to January 20th, 2023. This is to encourage you to finalize your numbers and for us to get you the materials/kits as early as possible. To minimize costs and simplify the process, clubs are encouraged to order SDP Materials (booklets, stickers, etc.) WITH their Enrolment Kits (toques and buffs).
