
Sun Peaks Nordic Club

Programs

- 24 children participated
- 9 coaches
- 8 week program

- Will add 14 and up age group next year
- \$17,300 Grant from Kamloops Blazers Foundation, of which we are using \$14,300 for Kids ski equipment, available for rental in 2014-2015 season
- Municipal Grant for training equipment
- Pacific Sport sponsors coach's training

Masters Program

- 8 week ski and fitness improvement
- 4 weeks skate, 4 weeks classic
- Limited to 15 participants.
- Two Level 3 CANSI leaders, one Level 1 came aboard part way through
- Lots of technical improvement in the participants' skiing
- Attrition due to illness and injuries were an issue, so we are changing delivery for next year to sessions of twice a week for two weeks on Skate, and repeating for Classic.
- Raised close to \$1760 for the club.


Social Programs

- Kookaburra Cup 2, 4, 15 and 30 K with age categories. 124 participants (double last year's registration). Co-hosted by SPNC and SPRC. Maintaining same date for next year.
- Holy Cow Loppet with 2, 5, 12 and 24 KM events hosted 96 participants. This is almost double last year's registration. Co-hosted by SPNC and SPRC.
